Access and Inclusion Working Group

Parent support group for NDIS

The NDIS is a national scheme. The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) is an independent agency that has been set up to deliver the NDIS. The NSW Government, the Commonwealth Government and the NDIA are working together on implementation of the NDIS.

The roll out of the NDIS in NSW will be staged over two years with full implementation due for completion by June 30 2018. Some of the schools within our directorate have begun transitioning to the NDIS in July of this year, with the remainder to commence in July 2017.




School contributions
