Most students in Years 3, 5, 7, and 9 are expected to participate in NAPLAN tests and schools should not exert influence on parents to withdraw their child from the tests. Adjustments can be provided for students with disability to enable them to access the tests on an equivalent basis as students without disability, and should be discussed with your child's school prior to the tests. Some students with significant intellectual disability and/or those with significant coexisting conditions which severely limit their capacity to participate in the tests may be exempted from sitting the online tests.
