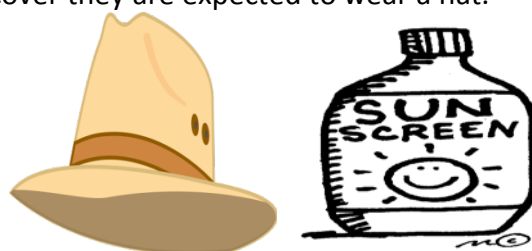
### COMBINED THURSDAY AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES WITH GUNNEDAH SOUTH PUBLIC SCHOOL:
