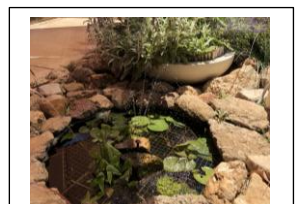

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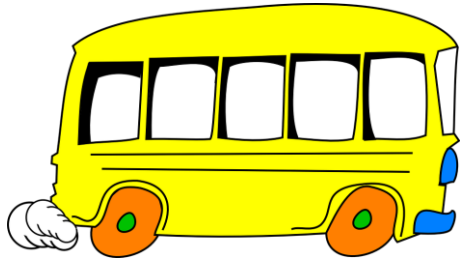
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Some of our staff and students recently assisted at the Links For Life Disability Expo in Tamworth. Their hard work and efforts were very much appreciated.

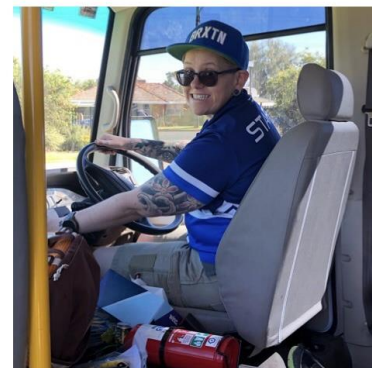

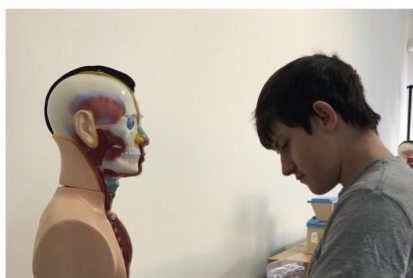
## First stop in Dubbo..... The Royal Flying Doctor Service.

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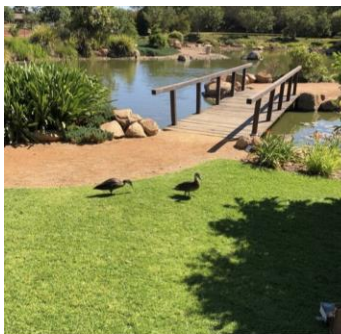


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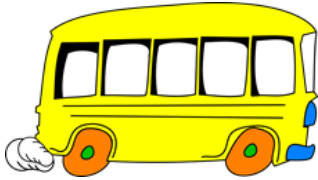
