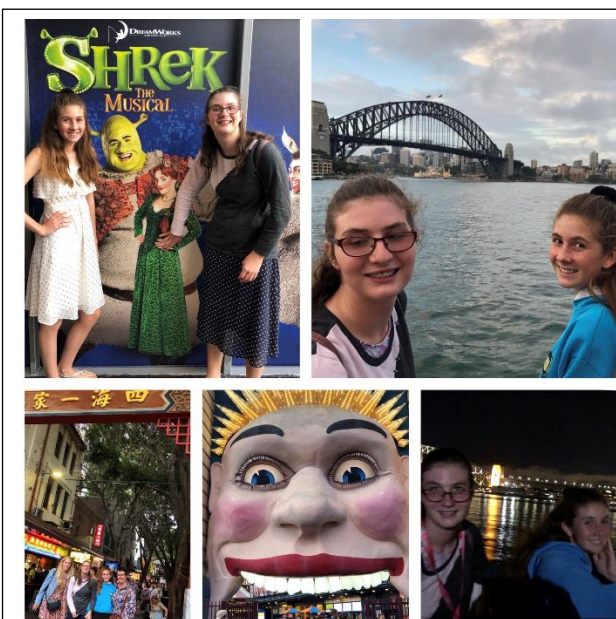
WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL
