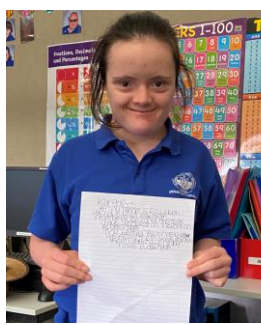

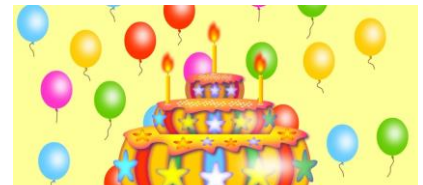

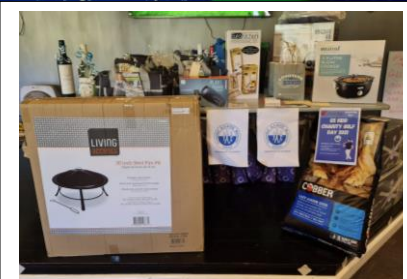


G.S. Kidd School P & C Golf Day 2021

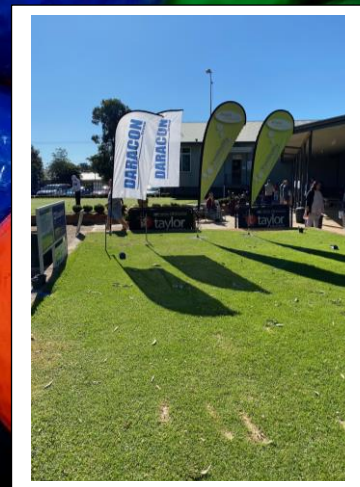


Last Sunday the G.S. Kidd School P & C held a very successful Golf Day. There were 11 teams and 43 players entered and all enjoyed a great day.

A huge thank you to our major sponsor **Idemitsu Boggabri Coal** who has always been very supportive of G.S. Kidd School for many years now.



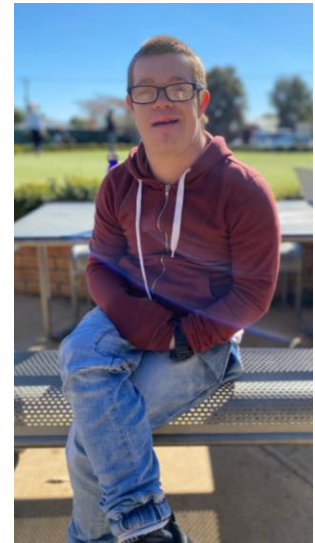

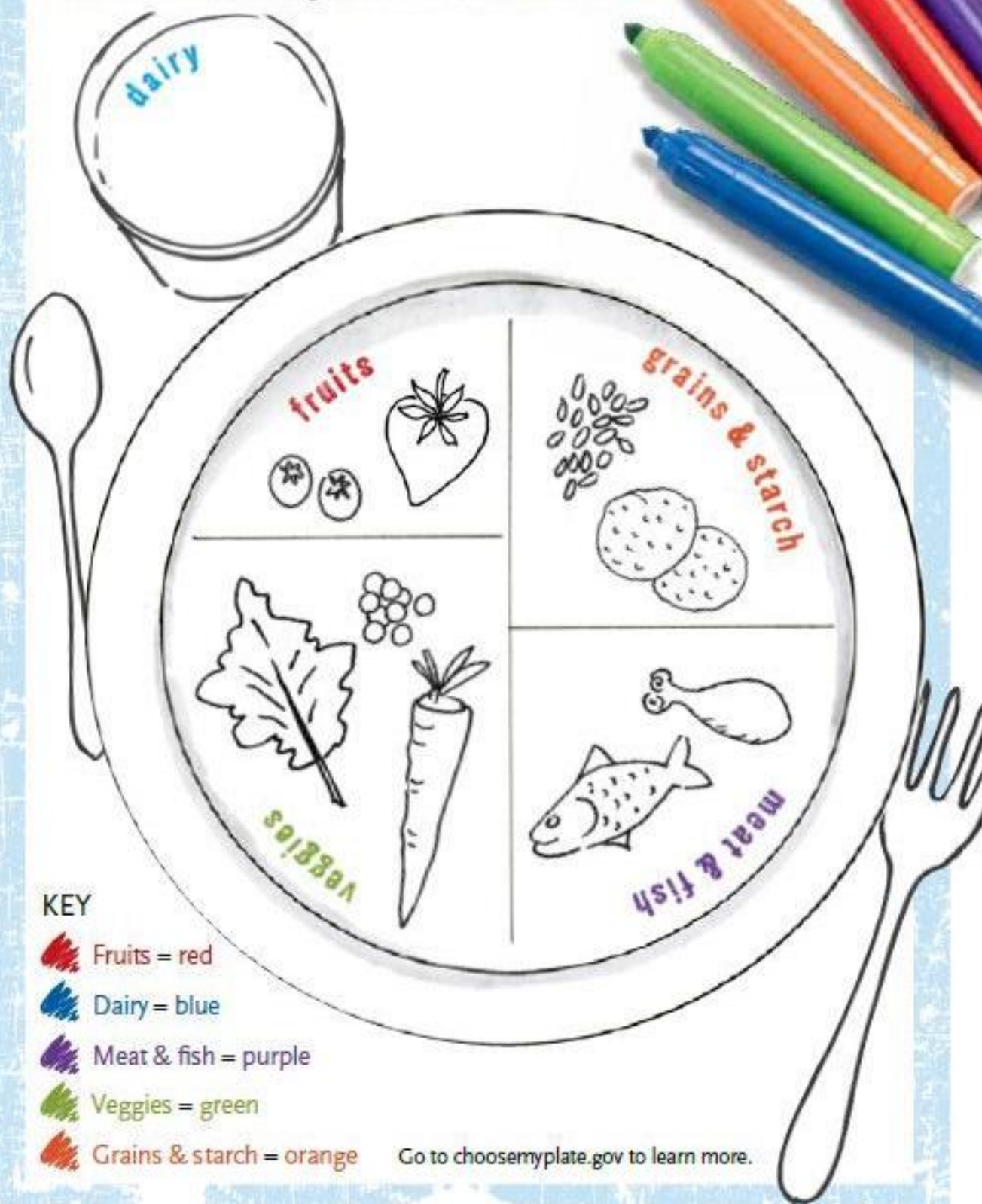

MONDAY is ...

Pack PURPLE/BLUE Day



A child-friendly way to "pack purple" is with 100% grape juice made with Concord grapes, snack-sized raisins, or blueberries (fresh, dried, or frozen).



TUESDAY is ...

Pack WHITE/TAN/BROWN Day



Bananas, white peaches or even cauliflower with dressing makes a nice choice.



WEDNESDAY is ...

Pack RED Day



Strawberries are a favorite, and other tasty options are red pepper slices, tomato wedges, or a delicious red apple.



THURSDAY is ...

Pack YELLOW/ORANGE Day



Baby carrots are easy to pack and so are dried apricots or orange segments.



FRIDAY is ...

Pack GREEN Day



Go green with celery sticks, broccoli florets, or a crisp green apple.

QR Codes for Schools

The Service NSW COVID safe check-in is required for visitors to the school, complimenting existing school visitor sign-in processes, including the external visitors to the school site form.

Visitors signing in at the front desk should self-serve using the COVID safe check-in tool as displayed in the poster. Schools should adapt the COVID safe check-in within their existing process for visitors to their school.
